



2020 Call for Applications –Wellness for Boys Summer Camp Program

Second Story Women's Centre (SSWC) supports women and gender-oppressed people, provides safer spaces and advocates for social change.

SSWC is requesting applications for the position of **Facilitator** for our Wellness for Boys virtual Summer Camp Program. This is a short-term contract position from the beginning of June to late August, 2020. Work commitment is 32 hours a week over 12 weeks.

Wellness for Boys is a free virtual camp program for boys aged 9 –12 that offers guided wellness opportunities and craft activities. The camp is designed to remove financial barriers that may prevent young boys from attending a virtual camp. Camps are offered in 4-day blocks over the course of 7 weeks. Wellness for Boys is dependent upon funding from Service Canada.

Duties

- ✓ Develop virtual program.
- ✓ Promote the program through social media and community partners.
- ✓ Deliver seven virtual summer camps for boys in Lunenburg and Queens County.
- ✓ Work collaboratively with SSWC Staff and potential guest speakers.
- ✓ Responsible for all aspects of the camps, including activities and scheduling
- ✓ Must implement appropriate online safety, use of technology and confidentiality measures.
- ✓ Communicate with parents and caregivers.
- ✓ Prepare a final report, including an evaluation of the program and recommendations.
- ✓ Must have access to secure and reliable internet.

The successful applicant will have a passion for and an interest in working with youth and will demonstrate an ability to work collaboratively in a feminist environment. Previous virtual program experience will be considered an asset. In addition, excellent communication, technology and leadership skills are required. References will be requested.
