



2021 Call for Applications – Boy-Identified Summer
Leadership Camps
Male-Identified Camp Facilitator

Second Story Women's Centre (SSWC) supports women and gender-oppressed people, provides safer spaces and advocates for social change.

SSWC is requesting applications for the position of **Male-identified Camp Facilitator** (as this camp will explore ideas of masculinity) for our Boy-Identified Summer Leadership Camps. This is a short-term contract position from early June to late August, 2021.

Leadership Camp is a free, 3-day summer day camp program for boy-identified young people aged 9 –12 that offers leadership building, empowerment opportunities and recreation. The camp is designed to remove financial barriers that may prevent young people from attending a summer camp. Camps are offered for 4 weeks in Lunenburg and offsite for recreation during the summer. Leadership Camps receive funding from the United Way of Lunenburg County, and through Service Canada.

Employment terms: 6 non-continuous weeks @36 hours/week @ \$16/hour

Duties include:

- Work collaboratively with the Youth Services Coordinator, other staff and guests to deliver seven 4-day summer camps in Lunenburg (day camps, not overnight). Offsite locations are being considered.
- Take part in training sessions and orientation with SSWC staff as required.
- Responsible for all aspects of the camps, including activities, snacks, scheduling, supervision of campers, and the implementation of appropriate safety and confidentiality measures.
- Communicate with parents and caregivers.
- Prepare a final report, including an evaluation of the program and recommendations for future years.
- Develop promotional video from footage throughout the summer.
- Officially thank community collaborators and partners.
- Ability to flexibly respond to public health recommendations and adapt camp accordingly with possibility of remote options.

The successful applicant will have a passion for and an interest in working with youth and will demonstrate an ability to work collaboratively in a feminist environment. Previous experience will be considered an asset. In addition, excellent communication, technology and leadership skills are required. References will be requested.
